### The Situation

Kincoppal-Rose Bay School of the Sacred Heart is a leading Catholic independent school that is part of the international network of Sacred Heart schools. Located in Rose Bay in Sydney's Eastern Suburbs, the School is co-educational (P-6) and girls only day and boarding (Years 7-12).

With over 130 years of educating hearts and minds, Kincoppal-Rose Bay prepares its students for lives of courage and confidence, educating them to discover their purpose, cultivate their talents and passions, and commit themselves to service as global citizens of the world.

While the School is steeped in tradition, it employs the latest technologies, and techniques to educate and protect its students. The focus is on the 'positive education' of the whole student.

The School has embraced the use of technology in classrooms and this put a huge strain on its previous internet management platform. Some of the challenges faced by staff and students included:

- 1:1 laptop programs for students in years 7-12 meant that students had a device they could connect to the internet outside of the control of the school.
- Increased use of social media without appropriate controls.
- Lack of visibility of underlying pastoral care issues.
- Slow internet performance, which meant that teachers could not take advantage of rich media and eLearning opportunities as much as they wished.
- Web filtering technology that blocked access to genuine learning tools and online content.

### Benefits

#### Student Welfare

- Using CyberHound's ClearView, the School is able to enforce the principles around student respect and support for each other – even across the use of social media platforms.
- All social media communications are monitored so inappropriate language is blocked before it reaches its target. Perpetrators can be identified and misuse can be managed.
- The School is able to manage internet use on school-owned laptops whether they are on the school network or outside the network (i.e. at home, on the bus or elsewhere).
- ClearView can identify unusual patterns of communication that may indicate a student is in need of support (i.e. suffering bullying, using drugs, considering self harm). These evidence-based triggers are crucial for pastoral care staff to act quickly to identify and assist 'at risk' students.

#### Internet Use

- CyberHound technology allows the School to enforce controls over the use of the internet at various time of the day (e.g. during homework time and late at night).
- Boundaries can be set for students around internet use with different policies for each year group – providing a tremendous degree of flexibility for staff.
- Reliable controls can be set over the use of the internet with none of the previous issues of genuine educational content being blocked.

#### Internet Performance

- CyberHound's technology dramatically improves internet performance without any internet link upgrades or cost. The CyberHound platform is designed and optimised for high throughput across the most demanding of networks.
