Staff VPN set up guide for Macintosh

This simple guide will enable you to set up a VPN connection to the school network. This ensures security on the connection which is important given the sensitive nature of the data and applications.

Requirements

The CyberHound certificate MUST be installed and trusted before continuing. When on the local network, browse to <u>http://cert.localnetwork.zone</u> from your device and follow the instructions. If offsite, please contact for assistance.

MacOS Version: 10.12 (Sierra) or later

configuration To create a new VPN Connection:


1. Go to System Preferences > Network

- 2. Click on the "+" symbol (lower left) to create a new VPN configuration
- 3. In the Interface drop down select VPN
- 4. In the VPN Type drop down select IKEv2
- 5. Enter a meaningful name in the Service Name input field
- 6. Click on Create

This will create and select the new VPN Connection, which we now need to enter the following connection details for:

- Server Address:
- Remote ID: Same as
- Local ID: Your **Username**
- Authentication Settings...:
 - Set dropdown to **Username**
 - Username: Your **Username**
 - Password: Your **Password**

Once all the above details have been entered, click **Connect** to test.
